8th GRADE STUDENTS ONLY SPECIAL NOTE FOR: A PASSPORT WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THE MINISTRY TRIP IN MAY. IT GENERALLY TAKES A FEW MONTHS TO RECEIVE IT AFTER APPLYING. PARENTS MUST BRING PROOF OF PASSPORT APPLICATION INTO THE OFFICE BY NOVEMBER 15, 2018.

FOR CLASS USE – These items will be shared

- 1 Boxes of Kleenex tissue (may need more later in the year)
- 1 Bag of pencil top erasers
- 1 Watercolor Set (Crayola work best)
- 1 Set of 12 colored pencils (*CRAYOLA* work best)
- 1 1" white clear-view binder (Math/English/Science)
- 1 Packages of 3"x 5" **LINED** index cards
- 1 Black Sharpie
- 1 Mead Composition Books

FOR PERSONAL USE – Label these with student's name

These supplies are essential on a daily basis and must be available at all times for use in the classroom. We suggest a pencil bag for some of these.

- 1 Simple Calculator (non-graphing)
- 1 Homework binder with a folder for holding homework
- 1 Pencil holder pouch (3 hole punched)
- 1 Quality hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 Binder paper College rule paper (Must always have some in binder)
- 1 Ruler
- 1 Set of *CRAYOLA* thin point markers
- 4 Mead Composition books (100 sheets 9 ¾" x 7 ½") (Bible/English/2 for Science & STEM Fair)
- 1 Composition book with **GRAPH PAPER** (9 ¾" x 7 ½") (Math)
- 1 Masterlock Combination Padlock w/ 1 ½" clearance (upstairs locker **no key locks**)
Lockers will be assigned when you turn in combinations to homeroom teacher on first day of school.
- 1 P.E. uniform/Dance clothes – P.E. uniform purchased through school office
- 1 Planner-**purchased from school office** as we use a specific one

Please note: 7th and 8th grade students will be responsible for all their own personal supplies. Classroom teachers will not be providing supplies that are on student list. As they approach high school a new responsibility level is expected. Some items may need to be replenished throughout the year depending on your child's use pattern and level of responsibility with their things.
